Street Tree Planting Species & Price List 2011-2012

- ◆ **\$50.00** for a 5 gallon tree, approximately 2-6 feet tall (depending on species), ¾ inch caliper, container grown: includes planting, initial mulching, fertilizing and one time watering at planting.
- ◆ **\$160.00** for a 15 gallon tree, approximately 6-8 feet tall, 1½ inch caliper, container grown: includes planting, initial mulching, staking , fertilizing and one time watering at planting.
- ◆ **\$300.00** for a 30 gallon tree, approximately 8-12 feet tall, 2 inch caliper, container grown: includes planting, initial mulching, staking , fertilizing and one time watering at planting.
- ◆ **\$675.00** for a 65 gallon tree, approximately 14-16 feet tall, 3 inch caliper, container grown: includes planting, initial mulching, staking, fertilizing and one time watering at planting.
- ◆ **\$1,150.00** for a 100 gallon tree, approximately 15-18 feet tall, 4 inch caliper, container grown: includes planting, initial mulching, staking, fertilizing and one time watering at planting.
- ◆ **Maintenance (watering) = \$ 75 per tree for one season (April-Sept.), recommended two, (minimum 10 trees).**
- ◆ **Home owners are responsible for watering and maintaining trees planted in their right-of-way.**
