BARBADOS CHERRY

Malpighia emarginata

Height: ~12 ft

Shade: Full sun to partial shade.

Conditions: Requires moist, well- drained soil when first growing. Small pink flowers are followed by bright red, sweet to tart-tasting, 1- inch fruits that are high in vitamin C. Trees are self-fertile and produce for months when watered well.

20TH CENTURY ASIAN PEAR

Height: 12-30 ft

Shade: Full sun preferred

Comments: Small, easy to grow tree that is heavy fruit bearing. Fruit is apple shaped with the sweetness of a pear and crispiness of an apple. Additionally, it has bright white beautiful flowers and is self fruiting!



BROWN TURKEY FIG

Ficus carica 'Brown Turkey'

Height: ~10-30 ft

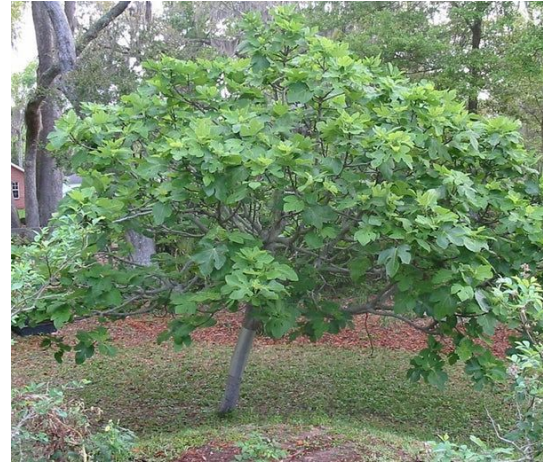
Shade: Full sun preferred

Comments: Self pollinating multi-stemmed woody shrub that produces two rounds of sweet fruit per year.

Note: Once picked figs stop ripening so make sure the fruit is ready before picking!

EIN SHEMER APPLE

Malus domestica 'Ein Shemer'

Height: ~10-15 ft

Shade: Full sun preferred

Comments: This tree produces a yellow, minimum sized apple that is sweet and semi acidic. The apples ripen in June and July and only require 350 chill hours

Note: This is a self-fertilizing tree but pollinates well with Anna and Dorsett Golden apples.



SANTA ROSA PLUM

Prunus salicina

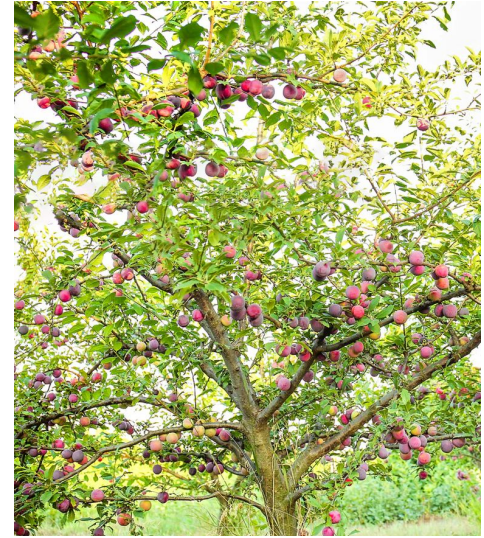
Height: ~10-20 ft

Conditions: Full sun preferred

Comments: Self pollinating, fast growing tree that produces large, sweet, red/purple slightly tart plums. Low chill hours.

SUN RED NECTARINE

Prunus persica 'Sunred Nectarine'

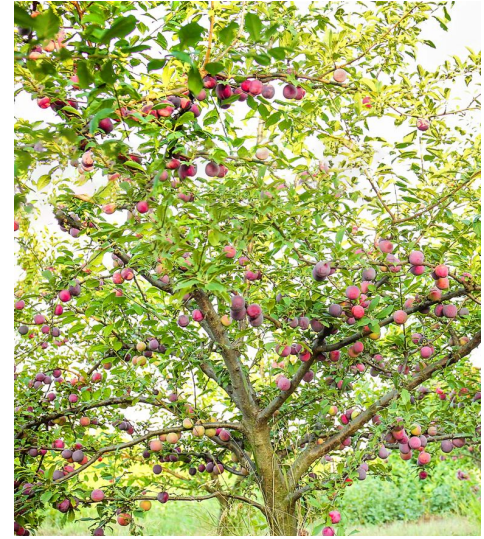
Height: 15-30 ft.

Conditions: Full sun

Comments: Self-fruitful tree that produces small to medium red, firm, semi-freestone fruit. Ripens May to June. 200-300 chill hours.

CLIMAX BLUEBERRY

Vaccinium virgatum

Height: 6- 10 ft.

Width: 3-10 ft.

Conditions: Full to partial sun

Comments: This is an early ripening Rabbiteye Blueberry species. Most of its fruit ripens in May. Crop load is moderate to high with 310-420 chill hours.
