# Callicarpa americana

Height: ~3-8 ft fall and usually just as wide

Shade: Full to partial shade, intolerant to full

shade.

**Conditions**: Bushy shrub that produces

magenta berries that wildlife love.

### **EASTERN REDBUD**

#### Cercis canadensis var. canadensis

Height: ~20 ft


**Conditions**: Full to partial sun preferred

<u>Comments</u>: Heart shaped glossy green leaves with vibrant pink to purple flowers in the spring. Flowers bloom early in the spring

Fun Fact: Several parts of the tree are edible

# Turk's Cap

### Malvaviscus arboreus var. drummondii

<u>Height</u>: ~2-5 ft

Conditions: Full sun to full shade

<u>Comments</u>: Small shrub that produces red hibiscus like flowers and is heat tolerant

<u>Fun Fact</u>: Trees For Houston has this species at our new facility. Hummingbirds have **loved** them!

### LIVE OAK

### Quercus virginiana

Height: ~50 ft

Conditions: Full sun preferred

<u>Comments</u>: Beautiful and popular shade tree in the Houston area. Wildlife love this tree!

<u>Fun Fact</u>: This tree is nearly evergreen shedding its leaves for only a few weeks every year

# **LOBLOLLY PINE**

#### Pinus taeda

Height: ~60 ft

Shade: Full sun preferred

Comments: Very fast growing pine with a

long trunk and oval shaped crown.

# **TEXAS RED OAK**

## Quercus buckleyi

Height: ~35 ft

Conditions: Full sun to partial shade

preferred

<u>Comments</u>: Medium sized tree. Once established this variation is more drought tolerant than shumard oak and is heat tolerant. Foliage turns red in autumn.
