BARBADOS CHERRY

Malpighia emarginata

Height: ~12 ft

Shade: Full sun to partial shade.

<u>Conditions</u>: Requires moist, well- drained soil when first growing. Once established mature plants are drought tolerant.

<u>Comments</u>: Small pink flowers are followed by bright red, sweet to tart-tasting, 1- inch fruits that are high in vitamin C. Trees are self-fertile and produce for months when watered well.

BILOXI BLUEBERRY

Vaccinium 'Biloxi'

<u>Height</u>: ~5-6 ft

Conditions: Full sun preferred but will

tolerate partial shade

<u>Comments</u>: Self-fertile plant with small-medium blueberries. Low to no chill hours and has long harvesting season (April-July)





BROWN TURKEY FIG

Ficus carica 'Brown Turkey'

Height: ~10-30 ft

Shade: Full sun preferred

Comments: Self pollinating multi-stemmed woody

shrub that produces two rounds of sweet fruit per year.

Note: Once picked figs stop ripening so make sure the fruit is ready before picking!

Florida King Peach

Prunus persica- "Florida King"

Height: ~15 ft

Shade: Full sun preferred

Comments: This self pollinating tree produces a large sweet peach May to Early June. Tree begins to bear fruit at age 3 and only needs 150 chill hours under 45 degrees to produce fruit.



HOSUI PEAR

Pyrus pyrifolia 'Hosui'

Height: ~8-20 ft

Shade: Full sun

<u>Comments</u>: Self Pollinating tree that produces round pears that ripen in August, beautiful white flowers in the spring, and orange-red fall color.

PRAIRIFIRE CRABAPPLE

Malus 'prairifire'

Height: ~15-20 ft

Conditions: Full Sun

Comments: Has bright red spring flowers, showy fall foliage, and red-purple edible fruit. Established tree can tolerate short periods of drought.
