BOTTLEBRUSH

Callistemon rigidus

<u>Height</u>: ~10-25 ft

Conditions: Full sun preferred

<u>Comments</u>: Bushy fast growing shrub-like tree with red "Bottle Brush" looking flowers. Tree requires little maintenance once grown





CHERRY LAUREL *Prunus carolinana*

<u>Height</u>: ~10-20 ft

Conditions: Full to partial sun preferred

<u>Comments</u>: Showy, dense, fast growing evergreen shrub or small tree. Small white seasonal flowers. Requires deep soil and grows 1.5 ft per year.

Note: Cherry Laurel is not edible





ELDERBERRY

Sambucus nigra ssp. canadensis

<u>Height</u>: ~12 ft

Growth: Fast grower

Conditions: Full sun if watered well

<u>Comments:</u> Shrub like tree that prefers moist but well drained soils.

Lifespan: 80-100 years

<u>Fun Fact</u>: The purple-black fruit is often used to make pies, jullies, wine, etc. Indigenous people used these fruit for medicinal purposes.





LIVE OAK *Quercus virginiana*

<u>Height</u>: ~50 ft

Conditions: Full sun preferred

<u>Comments</u>: Beautiful and popular shade tree in the Houston area. Wildlife love this tree!

<u>Fun Fact</u>: This tree is nearly evergreen shedding its leaves for only a few weeks every year
